On behalf of the community of Humåtak and the Umatac Municipal Planning Council ("UMPC"), we are kindly requesting approval of the Temporary Alcohol License submitted on behalf of the UMPC for the sale of alcohol products at the upcoming Humåtak Holiday Concert By the Bay on December 22, 2024.

The UMPC is hosting the Humåtak Holiday Concert By the Bay on December 22, 2024 from 12pm to 8pm. The UMPC has almost annually hosted our Guam History & CHamoru Heritage Day Festival which is a 3-day event and we are familiar with the Department of Revenue & Taxation's requirements for the sale of alcohol products at these type of community events. As the Humåtak Holiday Concert By the Bay on December 22, 2024 is a smaller 1-day event from 12pm to 8pm, it is our intent to have four (4) individuals with ABC licenses to man the beer booth.

We have submitted all required documentation and are hopeful that the ABC Board will approve our Temporary Alcohol License for this event.

# **Holiday Village Security Plan**

# <u>Overview</u>

The security plan ensures a safe, organized, and enjoyable environment at the Holiday Village, with specific measures to manage entry, monitor the venue, and enforce age restrictions during the event. The plan combines on-site personnel, technology, and clear protocols to address potential risks effectively.

# **1. Venue Access Control**

Front Entrance ID Check (6 PM - 11:59 PM):

- Purpose: Verify the age of attendees entering the Holiday Bar (21+ only).
- Process:
  - a. A designated security staff or team member checks government-issued IDs (driver's license, passport, etc.).
  - b. Wristbands are issued for verified 21+ attendees to clearly identify those permitted in the bar area. (red & green wristbands - see attached images)
  - c. Signage at the entrance will state the 21+ policy and list acceptable forms of ID.

# **General Entry Management:**

 Attendees under 21 are welcome to enjoy the market areas but are prohibited from entering the bar section. Clear signs and physical barriers will delineate these areas.

# 2. Surveillance and Monitoring

# **CCTV Monitoring:**

- Dusit Place's 24-hour CCTV system will cover all key areas, including entry points, the bar area, vendor stalls, and common spaces.
- Security personnel will monitor live feeds from the CCTV system to promptly identify and address any suspicious activity.

# **Roaming Security Guards:**

- 24/7 security guards will patrol the venue, with a focus on high-traffic areas during event hours (6 PM – 11:59 PM).
- Guards will coordinate with event staff to ensure smooth crowd management and respond to incidents.

# **3. Age Restriction Enforcement**

Holiday Bar Age Policy:

- Only 21+ attendees are allowed in the designated Holiday Bar area.
- Security guards will monitor entrances to the bar area and conduct random wristband checks inside the space to prevent unauthorized access.

**ABC Compliance:** 

 ABC licensed staff on-site serving alcohol will be instructed to verify wristbands before serving drinks.

# 4. Emergency Preparedness

Incident Response Protocol:

- Any disturbances, disputes, or emergencies will be reported to the on-site roaming security team and event management.
- A communication plan will be in place using radios or cell phones to ensure quick coordination.

Medical Assistance:

- A designated first aid station will be available on-site.
- Emergency contact numbers for local law enforcement and medical services will be provided to all staff.

# **5. Communication with Attendees**

- Event Guidelines: Attendees will be informed of the security protocols (e.g., 21+ bar policy, ID checks) through:
  - Event signage.
  - Digital communications (website, social media).
  - On-site announcements.
- Lost & Found Station: A designated area for lost items or assistance will be set up and staffed during event hours.

# 6. Post-Event Review

After each event day, security staff and event organizers will conduct a brief debrief to discuss:

- Any incidents or issues encountered.
- Recommendations for improving security for future events.

#### ALCOHOL

Upon issuance of a Temporary ABC Permit, Setlist intends to sell alcohol – both beer and mixed liquorbased drinks – at the Event. Alcohol stations or bars will be staffed with ABC-compliant and trained staff. In order for a concertgoer to purchase alcohol, he or she will need to have an acceptable band on his or her wrist. In order to obtain a band, the concertgoer must present an acceptable picture identification card to Setlist Admissions Staff upon entry confirming that the (i) concertgoer is the person pictured on the identification card and (ii) that the concertgoer is over the age of twenty-one (21).

Upon positive identification, Admissions Staff will issue and fasten one (1) black wristband on the concertgoer. A picture of the black wristband is attached for review. Once fastened, the wristband should not be able to be removed or transferred. Alcohol station staff will be instructed to turn away any concertgoer whose band appears compromised.

Under the Concert Terms and Conditions, any person without a band who is found consuming alcohol will be removed. Additionally, any person found providing alcohol to a person without a proper wristband will be removed.
